Diving the Sea of Cortez

While I would categorize the Sea of Cortez as tropical- it is more sub-tropical and more challenging than your typical warm water diving. I recommend either a 5mm wetsuit, or a drysuit, being comfortable in currents and deploying a DSMB for this trip. These are things you can work on proceeding the trip so you are prepared- but something to keep in mind when signing up. One of the things I love the most about diving the Sea of Cortez is the variety of sea life-from whales and sealions, to endemic hermit crabs and colorful nudibranchs, to large underwater mountains of rock- there is something for everyone on these dives. The baja peninsula is a special magic place that can be enjoyed both on shore and underwater.



Cabo/ Dia de los Muertos Add on & Additional Days

While Cabo is one of your classic tourist destinations there is a certain vibe that is quintessential Mexico! We embark on our journey on a Sunday, so I would recommend flying in a day early to settle in and relax at Casa Bella boutique hotel. There are plenty of places to eat and things to do within walking distance so you do not need to worry about flying in day of. If you would like to fly in a day or two early- and do some diving or a shark Safari let us know and we will schedule it!



Since we are traveling over Halloween and Dia de Los Muertos- let's spend it in Cabo learning about Mexican culture and take in the vibrancy of such a special tradition! Add 3 additional days to the end of your trip to enjoy and explore Cabo over a weekend of celebration! After disembarking our vessel, we will head to SeeCreatures/ Casa Bella boutique hotel in Cabo for 2-3 additional nights to relax and see the sights of Cabo or dive locally with SeeCreatures. Activities are a la carte and depend on the group. It is also Marlin season so we may have an ocean safari day to snorkel with these amazing fish! Pricing for this part will be released closer to departure date- a few group activities may be booked for Dia de los Muertos but that is TBD at the moment.
